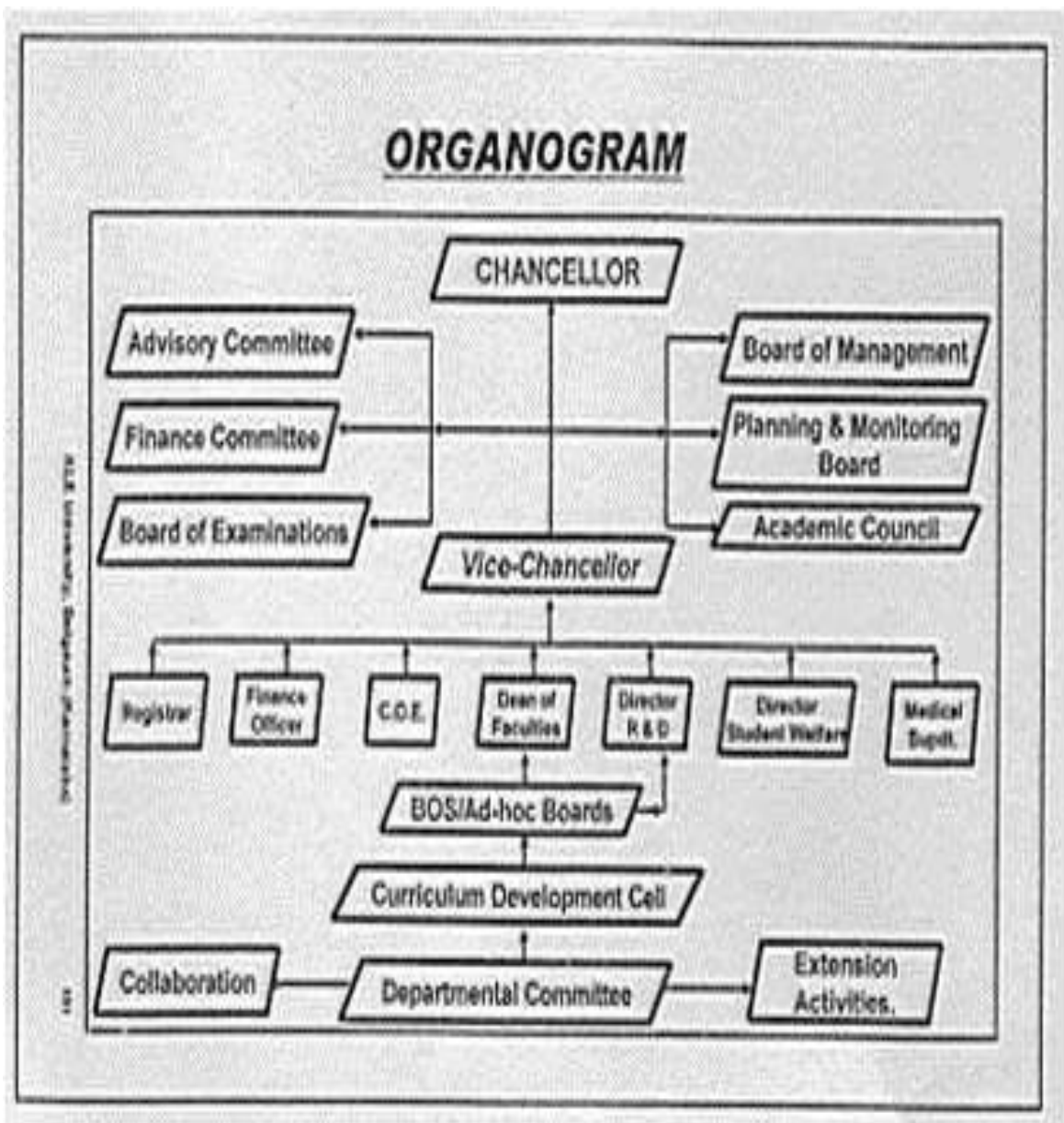

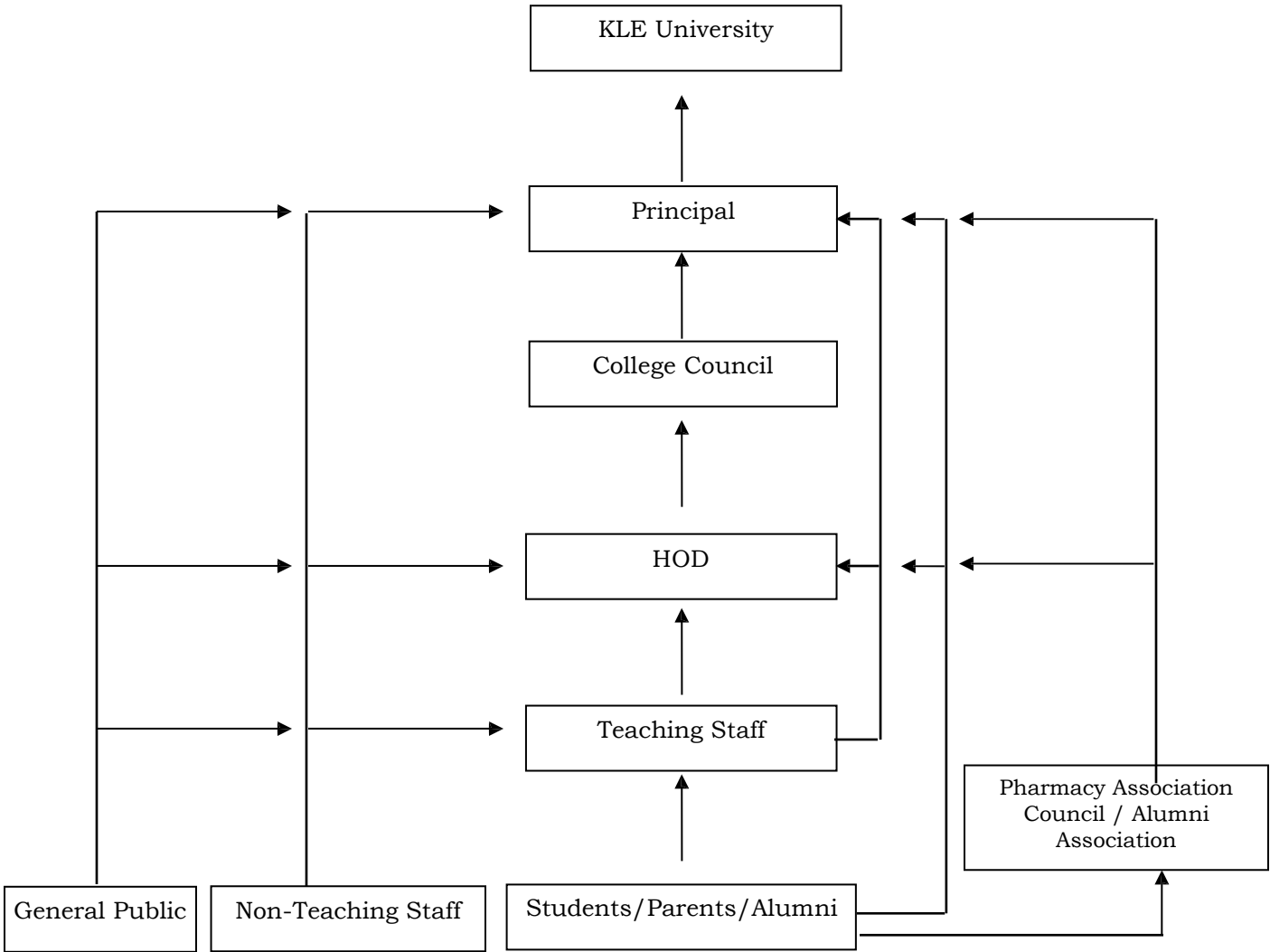

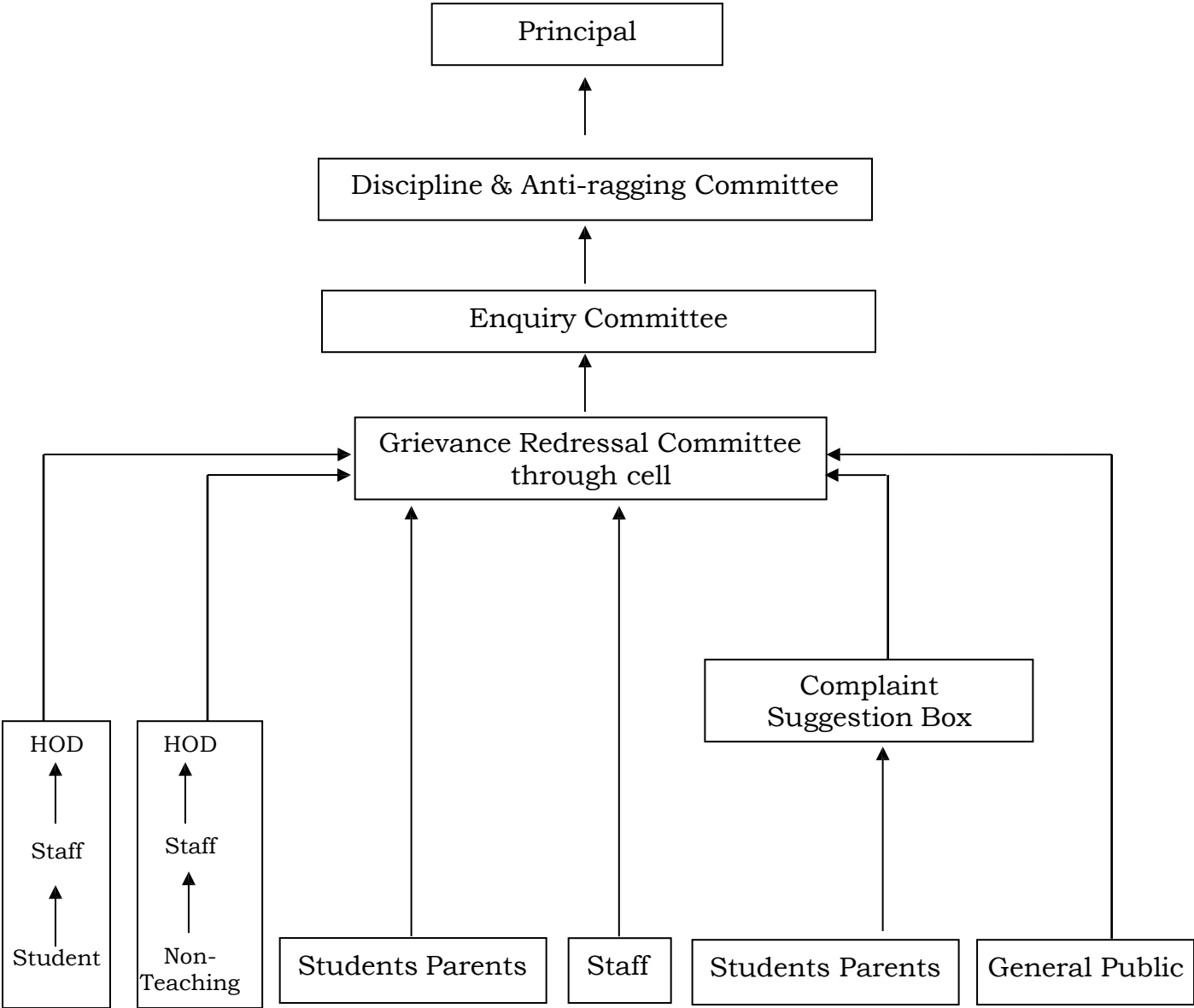

Cultural activities:

The Cultural Committee is constituted every year under the presidentship of the Principal. The Committee includes staff incharges for cultural activities followed by General Secretaries selected from III-B.Pharm. and Cultural Secretaries from IV-B.Pharm.

The Student Association organizes various co-curricular and cultural events every year. The Association also organizes and celebrates different special days like traditional day, saree and tie day, chocolate day, miss-match day etc. Different competitions like, rangoli, mehendi, bluff master, essay, debate and class room decoration are organized. Every year various cultural events are organized on talents day and on this day the different competitions like, dance (solo and group), singing (solo and group), skit, quiz, antakshari, fashion show, mimicry and mono acting are held and winners of which are announced the same day.

The College Annual Day is organized every year. On this day the rank holders, toppers and winners in academics, sports and cultural events are honoured and felicitated.

Sports activity:

The Sports Committee is constituted every year under the presidentship of the Principal. The Sports Committee includes staff incharges for Sports activities followed by sports Secretary selected from III-B.Pharm Sports activities such as indoor and outdoor games are conducted annually. Rolling shields have been instituted for various activities. Students are also encouraged to participate in Intercollegiate competitions and tournaments on invitation from other institutions.

Literary activities:

The Literary Committee is constituted every year under the presidentship of the Principal. The Committee includes staff incharge for Literary activities followed by Student's council. The Committee conducts literary activites such as Debate,essay writing,quiz competations etc. Students are also encouraged to participate in intercollegiate competations.

Magazine/News letter:

Recreation helps to shape the personality of students. In order to bring out hidden talents of the students and staff our college brings out infopharma, the college magazine once in every three years. To keep the students with update knowledge over the current affairs our college has also Inhouse monthly magazine once in a year which is a compilation of day to day articles related to science, research in the field of medicine, pharmacy, current affairs etc.

Technical activities:

So as to expose the students to preliminary research, final year B Pharm students are given research projects under faculty members as guides. The project titles are given to students departmentwise in which the students have to collect information and submit it in the form of booklet as per the guide lines .Final year B Pharm class teacher is the incharge faculty.

Industrial visits/ tour:

Industrial tour is organized for final B. Pharm students, during winter vacation (September/October) to visit various Pharmaceutical industries in and around Karnataka to get an orientation to the Pharmaceutical industries.

Alumni activities:

We have an Alumni Association, K.L.E. College of Pharmacy, Belagavi, which has been constituted in the year 1985. It is a network comprising of 1940 registered alumni who have been working in different fields such as pharma marketing, Industry, working abroad, hospitals etc since its inception, the association has developed and participated in many of the College functions and extra-curricular activities.
